***The Education of Henry Adams at 100: Centenary Reflections.*** 2018 is both the centenary of Henry Adams's death and the Houghton Mifflin first edition of *The Education of Henry Adams*. To mark these occasions we invite proposals for papers that address what Henry Adams says to us as we complete the second decade of the twenty-first century. Possible themes may include but are not limited to the following: new approaches to reading the *Education* (i.e. perspectives shaped by postcolonial studies, critical race theory, gender studies, eco-criticism, life writing/genre theory), reading Adams in the context of his literary or artistic contemporaries, the *Education* abroad (and in translation), reading Henry Adams in the Age of Trump. We are hoping to enlist 5-6 speakers to present concise 5-8 minute papers with ample time at the end for discussion.
