The Eugene O'Neill Society plans to have two panels at the American Literature Association convention in May 2018. Each 75-minute session will contain three 15-minute papers (roughly 2000-2500 words) and an open, half-hour discussion period with the panel's audience. - Reviews of specific productions of O'Neill's plays and the insights these particular interpretations provide
- The ways in which O'Neill's plays reflect themes and trends in American culture
- O'Neill's place in the development of American drama
