

The Percival Everett International Society (PEIS) invites abstracts of no more than 300 words from those wishing to make a presentation on Everett's work at the annual conference of the American Literature Association (see <https://americanliteratureassociation.org/ala-conferences/ala-annual-conference/>) in May 2020. Proposals for either individual papers or an entire panel may be submitted to the Society. Primary consideration will be given to scholarship that deals with one or more of the following topics, although any approach to Everett's work is welcome:

- Everett's poetry
- Everett's blending of genres
- The body in Everett's work
- Everett and history
- Everett's "one big novel"

ALA proposals should be submitted by email to Professor Anne-Laure Tissut (altissut@yahoo.fr) no later than 10 January 2020. Two panels, each typically featuring three presenters, will be sponsored by the PEIS at the ALA conference.
