

The International Susan Glaspell Society is sponsoring a panel at the American Literature Association conference in Boston May 23-26, 2019. The topic for the panel is: "A Woman's Honor: Susan Glaspell and the Provincetown Players." Susan Glaspell was often depended on by her first husband, George Cram Cook, to fill needs that arose with the Provincetown Players, asking her to do everything from writing plays at specific moments, particularly when submissions were waning in quality, to being one of two main readers of plays submitted for production by the group, to smoothing over disagreements among company members. Members are encouraged to submit papers for this panel that examine Glaspell's work with the Provincetown Players from 1915-1922, as playwright, as actress, as active member and part of the Players' executive committee, the other works she wrote during this period, and as wife of its leader. Papers on vital new research or broader contexts of Glaspell and her work will also be considered.

Papers should be no more than 20 minutes in read length (typically 8 pages double-spaced). Please submit titles and abstracts for papers to Jeff Kennedy at jtkennedy@asu.edu by January 20, 2019.
