This panel invites participants to consider what makes Jackson’s fiction feel particularly relevant in our contemporary sociopolitical moment. Papers may focus on apocalyptic and nuclear anxieties, the Anthropocene, the #MeToo movement, and any other topics that contextualize her current significance. We welcome, especially, papers that connect themes in Jackson’s work to the COVID-19 pandemic.
