The **American Literature Association** has welcomed Irish American Writers and Artists to be part of the 36th annual Conference on American Literature which will be held in **Boston on May 21st to 24th, 2025**. ALA is a coalition of Societies devoted to the study of American Authors, and our participation in the conference would be in keeping with President Higgins's recognition of IAW&A's mission in artistic and scholarly endeavors.

For our inaugural panel, we are issuing a broad call for papers on the topic of Irish-American voices in modern American culture, Some potential subjects could include the contributions of the McCourt Brothers, Irish songwriters (Irwin, Cohan, Boucicault and others), and the emergence of LGBTQ+ voices in America, Ireland, and beyond.
