The Marianne Moore Society **invites proposals for papers** about Moore's work, life, and ideas, her relationship to other poets and thinkers, and her work's relevance to issues of her moment and ours.

Proposals for both **individual papers** (20 minutes max) for a 75-minute session and for **full panels** (3 linked 20-minute papers) are welcome.

The ALA is organized by author societies and may host up to 2 panels for each society.
